

With reference to the subject cited and the letter under reference 7th cited, I submit that the following is the status of admissibility of the representation given by Sri. G.Venkat Ram Reddy and the clarification sought by Engg.-in.Chief,Irrigation &CAD Department, Hyderabad.

1. This office is in receipt of a letter vide reference 3rd cited for issuance of equivalency certificate with regard to T.Engineering (Civil) Part I and Part II examination conducted by the Institution of Civil Engineers (India) Ludhiana, Punjab, along with the syllabus and certificates.
2. In this regard it is to inform you that GOI, MHRD, Department of Higher Education in its notification No.F-24-1/2007 –TS.III. dated 06-11-2007 , that Government of India has recognized Part-I and Part-II of T,Engineers as equivalent to Diploma in Civil Engineering conducted by ICE (I) Punjab for the purpose of employment to the posts and services under Central Government
3. AICTE vide F.No.Equvi/AB/Gen.Corr./2008-09 dated 16-09-2008 informed that the said degree/diploma are valid as per syllabus approved by AICTE w.e.f. the academic sessions 2007-08 for the purpose of employment to the posts and services under Central Government. (Copy enclosed). Similarly, the syllabi and courses of SBTET are approved by AICTE and SBTET is issuing equivalency

Certificate in respect of similar diploma courses approved by AICTE and conducted by other State Boards of Technical Education irrespective of the quantum of syllabus.

4. Further it is informed that in G.O.Ms.No.386 of Education (EC-2) Department Dated 25-10-1994, Government has issued orders that, all qualifications recognized by Government of India are automatically recognized by the A.P. State Government for employment purpose, which is further reiterated by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in its Memo 4th cited wherein it is stated that No separate Orders are necessary (Copy enclosed for ready reference).

In the light of the above, it is to inform that the afore mentioned qualification is valid.
